**Recruitment Criteria for the Post of Fireman (F&ES)  
and Emergency Rescuer (SDRF):**

• **Eligibility Criteria :**

In order to appear in the Direct Recruitment Tests for the post of **Fireman (F&ES)** and **Emergency Rescuer (SDRF)** a candidate must satisfy the following criteria.

- (a) **Nationality** :- A Candidate must be an Indian citizen and ordinarily resident of Assam.
- (b) **Age** :-  
(i) **For the post of Fireman (F&ES) and Emergency Rescuer (SDRF)**: A candidate should be 18 to 25 years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the year of advertisement.  
**Relaxation**: Upper age limit is relaxable as under:  
(i) 5 (five) years in case of candidates belonging to SC, ST (P) & ST (H).  
(ii) 3 (three) years in case of candidates belonging to OBC/MOBC.

**Note:** For the purpose of determining the age limit, the **Appointing Authority** will accept only the date of birth as per Admit Card/Certificate of matriculation or an equivalent examination issued by a recognized Board. No other document relating to age such as horoscope, affidavit, birth extract from Municipal Corporation, Health Department and Service Record etc. will be accepted.

- (c) **Educational Qualification**:- Class- XII passed (**Science**) from a recognized Board or Council.
- (d) **Physical Standard for candidate**:-

- (e) **Medical Standards**:
- (i) **General**: Candidate must not have knock knee, flat foot, squint eye, unsound mind, stammering, skin disease and should possess high colour vision. Varicose veins shall be considered a temporary disqualification. He must be in good mental and physical health. He must be free from any physical deformities and free from diseases such as diabetes, hernia, piles, respiratory diseases or any other ailment that is likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties.
- (ii) **Eye sight**: The distant vision should be 6/6 for at least one eye and not poorer than 6/9 for the other without correction. Near vision should be normal.
